THE STUDY TOUR

- A trimester 3 unit: CSP or fee-paying
- Opportunity to gain knowledge about social health / health systems in the developing world
- **Not a holiday**; a very rewarding experience
- Pre-tour commitments (must attend Nov 25th workshop)
- **Assessment tasks**: pre-tour, on tour & post-tour
- The tour includes
 - daily site visits (government; NGO & independent agencies)
 - tutorial activities and debriefing sessions
 - ... and some free time for tourist activities



CAMBODIA STUDY TOUR

- Travel overnight – depart Friday 6th January Evening flight
- Arrive Siem Reap – Saturday 7th January Morning flight
- Depart Cambodia (PP) – Monday 23rd January Evening flight
- Arrive Melbourne - Tuesday 24th January Morning flight
- CST tour - Including flying time

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Take it seriously

- Application is completed on-line (see next slide)
- Criteria:
 - Must be 18 years old (valid passport)
 - Academic record
 - Personal statement of what you want to gain from the Cambodian study tour experience – what you bring
 - Undergraduate students (2nd / 3rd year applicants only)
 - Postgraduate students
 - at least 4 PG units; more units is an advantage if not working in Public health field
 - Academic referee – name and contact details

STUDENTS ON THE TOUR

- **\$700** deposit required as security
- Travel organised through Deakin University
- Some flexibility with return dates (onward travel)
- Accommodation: shared or single
(you must let us know if you want a single supplement
preferably at the interview otherwise we assume
you are willing to share
accommodation)



ANTICIPATED COSTS

- **Cost:** ~ \$3200 inclusive of flights, ground travel, accommodation, some meals, some cultural and recreational activities and administration costs
- Food: cheaper than Australia
- Phone calls: local SIM card: cheap
- Passport application (you must have at least 6 months on passport prior the departure / finish tour)
- **Cambodian visa: \$30:00 (USD)** (this may change)
- OS-HELP Loans to help meet costs (criteria applies)
- **Scholarship support** – Undergraduate students are eligible, but allocated to best suited candidates
- Spending money



CST PROCESS & KEY DATES

- Student applications close Monday April 4th (5pm)
- CST interviews
 - Friday April 15th In person (Burwood) or phone
(Monday April 18th if needed)
- Notification of CST place – from Tuesday April 19th
- **Payment schedule: CST Deposit \$700 – due on 1 June**
 - 1st instalment \$1500 due on 1 August**
 - 2nd instalment \$1000 due on 1 September**
- 1st On-line session: Wednesday November 2nd @ 6pm
- 2nd On-line session: Wednesday November 16th @ 6pm
- CST November workshop: *Friday November 25th
(*DU City Centre – 500 Bourke St. Melbourne - all day)
