Definitions:

Abbreviation	Definition
UNU	Focus of the study is on unemployment. The focus of our meta-analysis is on employment.
ELSE	Unable to calculate either the employment elasticity or its standard error. Both are needed for publication selection bias correction.
BINARY	Study uses a binary dependent variable, reporting employment probabilities. Our study focuses on employment elasticities drawn from studies using a continuous measure of employment.
SELF	Focus of study is on self-employment.
DIST	Study looks at wage and income distribution effects.
