### **D312 Course Rules**

I understand that to qualify for the award of Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Laws (D312) I must complete 40 credit points. Also:

I must complete 16 credit points of study from the Faculty of Arts and Education including at least 4 credit points at level 3, plus either two major sequences\* of at least 8 credit points each or one major sequence\* of at least 8 credit points and one minor sequence\*\* of at least 4 credit points.

I must complete 24 credit points in the Bachelor of Laws, including 16 credit points of core units and 8 credit points of ILLB electives.

In addition, I am required to complete the prescribed Professional Experience and MCA010 Communication for Academic Studies (0 credit point unit) in order to be eligible to graduate.
