Your enrolment antenna technology today that will be showing you important days in our system, your course trucker Andrew. Andrew coming along with talking about the work integrating learning where we go next. Forget somehow and now telling you about what next from the Enrolment session today.

Alright, I will be handed over to Andrea Robinson for stop sharing and then Andrew incentive show you how to get into to the student connect and how to enrol. Thanks, Andrea

Thanks Nonny and thanks everyone for joining us.

Sorry, I just

Andrea Robinson - Deakin University: sharing, sharing. Yep.

No worries. I'll pop my screen up

Okay, so hopefully you should be saying

Quite a blank screen with a little logo in the middle on the inside.

So basically what I'm going to talk to you through his as an auntie mentioned just a brief sort of outline of student connect and how to enrol and some of you have probably already

Gone through this, but hopefully. There might be a few things we can share with you that are useful so

In your offer email from deacon, you will have received a link that actually starts the process which is to activate your Deacon account.

And all the details should be in that offer email in terms of your student ID and course code.

And what will happen is, once you activate that account. It will take you to the next step in the process which is into DeakinSync and that screen looks like this one.

So here you'll see in the top left hand corner in the green sort of box. I guess we'll call it

Your offer for daikon, and you'll see a link to accept your offer and enrol. So this will actually take you through to what we call an enrolment checklist so you'll see

Your offering. Today we're going to demonstrate and offer in a triple three and there it is better of communication.

Digital Media. So I'm going to enrol into that offer. So this is the checklist that I referred to, it's basically just a, I guess, a set of screens with information for you.

In addition to what you've received in your offer email and it's certainly worth, I guess, having a quick look, if you can, before you start your enrolment journey.

You'll find this four steps on the left hand side here you can click between those. And you'll see on those particular steps, there's these little checkboxes, and they have information.

That we'd like you to review and this is where we first introduced you I guess to

The course map and the handbook. So you'll find if I click on to that I've got different information presented to me. So basically we ask that you go through these four steps and have a look at the information that's provided to you.

As we are on a time schedule here today. I'm not going to cover each screen. But basically, we'd like you to have a look at step three, in particular, and then when you come to. Step four.

You'll see there's a big green button there to enrol now and that's what will actually take you out to student connect itself. So when you click it.

It should pop up straight over with your login into student can. So this is the interface that you men ensure enrolment with and you also manage your details with us.

And you'll see on the top left hand corner here we've got personal details and you can at any time, update your preferred name and your contact details we first

And that's where you do it for the whole university. So that's a good reference point probably the easiest way to start enrolling is using a little pink button there for enrol and that will actually start the enrolment process.

If I pop right back in. Hopefully it'll load. So, today, as I mentioned, we're going to demonstrate a you'll see, you've got to click begin enrolment button. So if you click on to that.

It will start and present to you that the steps we want you to go through to fill out your information. So you'll see on the right hand side we've got a checklist there as well. So you know what

What's coming and what you've got to complete. So the first step ease the terms and conditions and here basically you'll find this references to the student code of conduct.

Other policies and procedures and your rights and responsibilities, you'll see we have some more information down here. So we just like you to read through this terms and conditions and once you're happy to proceed. Click the consent and accept button.

And that will take us to the next step. So here you'll be presented with your course information again. This one is an offer for board.

On campus and it is a common supported place. So this is where basically I start accepting and enrolling into the course by clicking that little box there I can hit save and continue

And then you'll be presented with your contact details here you find

There's already information that you've provided us through your application is that be direct or through the tack.

So we'd like you to review and see if anything needs updating you'll have an edit there. If that is the case, and you'll find if we missing some information from you. You have an ad button.

And so we ask that you complete any fields or sections that have the red Asterix because they are the required information that will actually need from you.

And an example of that is the primary emergency contact. So if you can ensure that you add one of those as well.

And once you're done on that particular screen hit the continue button and it will take you to the statistics for

So fortunately, you only have a half to fill this out once. There are a lot of questions in this particular form.

And basically, you'll notice I've pre filled this format, but I'll just go through these questions with you all the same. For those that haven't done this yet.

So the first question is about Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander descent. So you can obviously indicate there as required.

With citizenship in this demonstration we're using Australian citizen.

But obviously, there may be some of you that are permanent humanitarian visa holders or permanent visa holders. So you just indicate there accordingly and we may have some New Zealand citizens as well. So that's an option for students here in Australia.

The next question is about country of birth and what you have to do here is either select Australia.

Or if you're born overseas and sure you select from the list. So you'll find when you click the List button.

you're presented with another drop down option. And there are a lot of countries in the list and hopefully you'll find the appropriate country for where you're born, so I'll just cancel out of that so

That basically takes that question. If you were born overseas. What you need to do down here in this particular box is indicate the year that you arrived in Australia.

Now residents were looking for a permanent home residents here. So in Australia. We just want you to put the post code.

If you

Certainly from all of you that should be appropriate. Are there shouldn't be any students in the room. Hopefully that are residing overseas, but just in case. Again, there is a list button to select from.

And the second part to that question is where your residence is during the trimester or semester. So in case you are, you know, working away from home.

While you're doing a study or you're in a different location. You can obviously put a different post code there, but in the same postcode is perfectly fine. If you're in the one place

So language is the next question. We're looking for the language that you predominantly speak at home. So we've got English here or you can select again a language from a list there.

Yeah, secondary education. We've got few parts to this question.

Here we'd like you to select your highest level of education, you can play it at school. So you'll see this is in reference to secondary only and just select the appropriately year

In some cases, we've got not a clickable in in case they're not not accurate. So I just selected you 12 and we do them part asked for the year that you completed that that highest level. So I've just put in 2020 which would be the case if you did you 12 last year.

And the last part of the question is if you're commencing with us in an undergraduate course we'd like to know the postcode and the suburb of your home when you were last

Road last year. So, or the the you you were last enrolled. So it may be a bit repetitious of your postcode up above. But if you can put that in. Again, if applicable, and the suburb where you were.

So education level.

They may be some in the room who are mature age students. Obviously those may have done certificates and so on as above, if you've just completed you 12 and not done any other studies such as indicated here just select none of the above.

So of course. So what we're looking for here is the institution.

I'm going to jump to the third part part of the question, I guess, which is prior undergraduate institutions. So if you had done a bachelor degree or something in the above question.

We're actually looking to ask you where that was through that list button. But for most of you, if you're just commencing an undergraduate degree and you haven't done any study at side of secondary school you would indicate not commencing a postgraduate course.

And I don't think we'll have any students committing a postgraduate course in the room. But obviously, that's another option.

So, disability, you have a few options in this particular question. You can just say no if that's the correct answer.

If anybody wishes to declare a disability, you find you can declare a disability, and it is optional as to whether you want to select please contact me.

And to explain if you do indicate, please contact me. Our Disability Resources unit will be in contact with you to see what services we can offer you throughout your study.

So I'm going to select know for this demonstration and the lucky last question is about your parents or guardians highest educational attainment.

So you'll find again, there's a few options in the drop down if you don't know. You can select don't know. In this demonstration, I've selected bachelor degrees for. So basically, once you've answered all the questions you hit save and continue and it should take us on to the next step.

So the Commonwealth assistance form. There's two parts to this form as such. So everybody will need to actually complete this form to accept a Commonwealth supported place.

Whether you up to defer your fees to a hex help loan is entirely up to you and you'll find the first question you can actually answer.

On this form is this one here. Will you be studying at least one unit of study of your course in Australia.

So you would opt for yes and now it will provide you with your options. So if you wish to defer your fees to hex help loan you would put your text file number in the first box there.

If you don't have a text file number. You will need to get one as soon as possible. But if you have applied for one. You just haven't received it.

We do ask you to indicate, I have a certificate of application, which is what you should have received from the Australian tax office.

And when you indicate that you will be asked to upload a copy. So you can might be quickest to take a photo of that certificate with your phone and then upload that file as part of your process here.

In this demonstration, I'm actually going to nominate I do not want a hex helpline.

And basically, that means that I'm indicating I'm going to pay my contribution up front. And that means I have to pay my fees by the census date.

Certainly, Your options are, as you can see here to pay up front, or you do have to provide your tax file number by the census date and you'll hear about census dates more in this presentation.

So once you've nominated what what approach. You want to take in terms of this form, you just scroll down this information that you'll see here, in particular, again, it's flagged. I'm going to pay this up front and

Lots and lots for a reading for you there on that form and it just gives you information about how to access your, your loan and some things like that.

Okay, so we've got another Save and Continue button down the bottom. If you click on to that that will take you through

And say, yes, it has been processed it is immediate approval. You don't have to wait for your help line to be approved the seas approved essentially instantly. So there's no delay on that.

If you continue. We're going to go over to the essay help form. This is completely optional the student services and amenities fee is charged every trimester, that you are enrolled and certainly you can defer it to your hex help loan.

It will be bundled with your tuition phase, essentially, or you can pay it up front. So you've got to do either of those again by census date. In this demonstration, I'm just going to skip this. I don't want to defer it so I'll just hit the continue button here.

So we've got to the units selection screen. So this is, guess where you will do most of your enrolment as such in terms of adding units, possibly withdrawing from units.

And today we are showing a course we have actually put some units up here as unconfirmed to show you today.

And I have selected a range within the this particular course to choose from. And you'll see

I've got the trimesters indicated here on the very left column under period so Tier one is trimester one to two trimester two and so on.

I have the unit codes and names and you'll see campus here and delivery mode. And so this particular offer. I've been offered board, but I do have some units. I'm going to do through the cloud campus.

And you'll notice also these little information icons, you can actually click on to those and they will provide you with some more information about this particular item so

What delivery mode is what your statuses are census date and unit edit unit and what you can do with your units so

What I will actually do in this demonstration is I will confirm these units. So you just click on to confirm

And you'll get a prompt on each unit to say are you sure you want to confirm it. And I'll just quickly click through and confirm all of these ones. So we can then show you some more steps.

And so, in this instance, I am actually intending to enrol full time.

And that would be either three or four credit points for trimester one and trimester two and so you'll see the credit points column. I've got

Four For trimester one. And at the moment. I've only got three for trimester true. So what I'm going to do is I'm going to add an additional unit for trimester to and you'll see your add units button down the bottom of the screen.

This is a search. So you can search by unit code, you can search by title.

And of course you can also search by study period. So the all of those fields. You can search by. In this demonstration, I'm going to search by unit code because I have already had a look at the handbook. And I'm going to add

This particular unit IMD one on one.

And you'll see on the search, you'll get a list of results very similar to before. You've got unit code unit name, you will have census date presented to

You say a period column and a campus and delivery mode and so on. So, in this instance, you can toggle these as well. So if you want to reorder them.

If it makes it easier because I've got two pages of results. So what I'm looking for. I wanted to add this unit to my trimester to list and I can see down here. I've got a teacher.

Unit and it is bare wood and D represents Dave as a delivery mode. So if you're on campus student most of your units will be d for day. So I'm actually going to select that one.

So you've just got to make sure you clicked on the little box on that particular row and click the pink. Add button at the bottom.

And it will come up on your list. And you'll notice ones that you add will have a little message to say to be added. It hasn't been finalized yet so I can see

I still need to complete a step here. So down the bottom. We've got nine pending changes. So these are all units on the screen and actually have to click finish enrolling to finalize that

And every time you finalize your enrolment, you will see probably this particular box which just lets you know that your course is inactive, even though

Your units are enrolled. We'll have a look at that in a second. But you'll see it says it's going to go to enrolled on the first of March. This is just a message, you can certainly just click OK.

And you'll see now on the screen. This is actually presented me with a confirmation number, which means successfully gone through

And the statuses are all now the as enrolled so effectively. These units are enrolled. I'm happy about that. I've got them all enrolled. So what I can do from here is I can go back to current enrolment.

And I can see all the units. I'm enrolling for this year. If, for example, I had some work commitments as they do come up and I found I needed to withdraw from a unit.

What I would look to do is obviously check that it was, I still was able to do so. According to a handbook dates.

And certainly at the moment you can add in withdraw Tier one and Tier two units, without any problems or impacts to your face. So I'm actually just going to demonstrate

Withdrawing a trimester to unit. So you are familiar with the process. So we have a little discontinue little icon here.

And I'm going to withdraw from ALA 104. In this demonstration, it will ask me why I want to discontinue or withdraw from this unit. So there's a drop down list there and I'm just going to select work or family commitments and then click OK.

So you'll see it's come up in another colour and it's now giving me another pending change for me to finalize as part of this process. So,

Again, I have to click finishing rolling to actually save it until you click that button. Button. It's not saved, essentially. So again, I get the little warning message. I'll just click OK. And I can now see that this unit has a discontinued status. So I know that one is now withdrawn from

If I go back to my current enrolment. I can see there I've got still my enrolled list and I can see the discontinued unit. There is now.

Discontinued status so that effectively shows you, I guess, how to confirm units if they're pre loaded for you on your screen. How to Add and how to remove units, certainly, now that I've done effectively my enrolment, I can certainly navigate around student connect

Within my enrolment by just clicking across on the checklist so it's only into once you've completed all the steps you can do that.

So that makes it a bit quicker if you're coming back into student connect and you just need to make a change to a unit or your units, you can now click straight into number seven. So

That basically concludes our presentation on using student connect for enrolment. I might hand back to Nonny and I'll stop sharing my screen.

What do you want to do in will like I said everything that happens outside of classroom still a part of your course something that you can still do it for credit is work integrated learning

could include internship could include a lot of group projects individual professional projects as well. You could volunteer and whenever it is possible. You can also travel

Now it is all about. What do you want to do, how, how you want these experiences to compliment your study when you are finishing your course.

And also about what is your dream internship. What would you like to do

Of course through all this. We are here to help the work integrated learning team has got the support the services and the resources that are useful to you, and we hope that you would use to make sure

That you utilize all these experiences, to the best of your benefit and you will hear from us in the course of your time, you will see us in so many of your orientation activities, you will see us in maybe some of your

classes as well to just come and say hello. How can you do something that is relevant to this class, but that will all come in time for now perhaps what you can do is start thinking about building your own career for that.
