The remainder of my Arts credit points are made up of specifically Arts-coded electives (which can include other Criminology ACR coded units if I wish, but can also be any other Arts units from Deakin)

I must complete 16 credit points of Faculty of Health-coded units – including 13 core units (HPS104, HPS111, HPS121, HBS110, HBS107, HPS201, HPS202, HPS203, HPS204, HPS301, HPS307, HPS308 and HPS310)

I must complete 2 credit points of level 3 HPS electives or 1 level 3 HPS and 1 level 3 HXX units

I understand that if I decide to complete my studies with only one of these two degrees, I will come and speak to a Course Adviser for assistance
