DUELI offers a wide range of programs that will help develop your English reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills. All DUELI courses run for five weeks except for General English Elementary (GE 1) which is for 10 weeks. Most students attend DUELI for 10 to 20 weeks.

English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

📍 MELBOURNE, ONLINE¹
📅 5-20 WEEKS

You can meet the English language requirements of Deakin University undergraduate and postgraduate degrees by successfully completing an EAP direct entry pathway at DUELI. You will learn:

- report writing
- essay writing
- research skills
- critical thinking
- effective listening
- note-taking skills
- oral presentations
- how to actively participate in group and classroom discussions
- study skills.

General English (GE) Programs

GE Elementary to Advanced levels

📍 MELBOURNE
📅 5-45 WEEKS

General English Elementary (GE 1) is a 10-week program. However, you can exit after five weeks with an overall score of 55% plus 17 in Writing. GE 2 and above are five weeks long per level. You will have 25 hours per week of study, including 5 hours of independent learning with help from a teacher. To move from one GE level to the next you need to pass the main assessment tasks of your current level with an overall score of 55%.

General English students will:

- learn English for everyday situations
- communicate with other students in class
- learn to speak accurately and clearly
- improve their pronunciation and fluency
- extend their vocabulary
- continue to develop cross-cultural communication skills.

Introductory Academic Program

📍 MELBOURNE
📅 5 WEEKS

In this program you are given particular tasks that help you develop the writing, reading, listening and speaking skills needed to be successful at university.

This program is for high level students who have already met requirements for their award course (IELTS 6.5 or equivalent). It will prepare you for undertaking higher level studies at Deakin University. Each week of the IAP program focuses on a range of tasks and academic themes to ensure success when you commence your award course.

English for Commerce



MELBOURNE

5 WEEKS

The English for Commerce program is for students wishing to develop their English skills for accounting, law, finance and marketing.

Entry prerequisites

To enrol in the English for Commerce program, you will need to complete DUELI EAP 2 with a score range of 60% or equivalent, or achieved the required DUELI placement test score for entry to this program.

English for Teaching



MELBOURNE, ONLINE¹

5 WEEKS

The English for Teaching program is a high-level, intensive program that will prepare you for entry into a Bachelor of Education or Master of Teaching programs and graduate certificate programs in teaching at Deakin University. You will be assessed on your writing and listening skills, as well as a literature review and group presentation.

Entry prerequisites

Students who wish to enrol in this program must have an IELTS score of 7.0 (no band lower than 7.0) or have completed a DUELI EAP 4 program with an overall score of 70%. Please note this course is only offered in Intakes 1 and 9.

IELTS Preparation



MELBOURNE, ONLINE¹

5 WEEKS

The IELTS Preparation course is designed for you to achieve success in the IELTS examination. You will become familiar with the IELTS examination format; improve listening, reading, writing, and speaking skills; and learn strategies for dealing effectively with the tasks in the practice IELTS examination under timed conditions.

Entry prerequisites

To enrol in the IELTS Preparation course you must have a minimum IELTS score of 5.5 or equivalent.



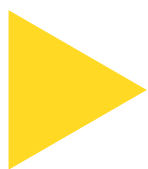
STUDY TOURS – ONLINE AND ON CAMPUS

Application process

Applying to DUELI is easy and our Admissions Team is ready to process your application quickly. But you should lodge your application as soon as possible as places at DUELI fill up fast.

1. COMPLETE YOUR APPLICATION FORM

Complete the DUELI application form.

This can be done **online** through the StudyLink Connect platform at student-deakin.studylink.com.

Or by completing the form on pages 11–12 and:

OR, APPLY IN PERSON

You can also apply in person at a Deakin University office in Melbourne, Jakarta or New Delhi. Visit deakin.edu.au/international-students/contact-us for office addresses.

2. WAIT FOR YOUR LETTER OF OFFER

Once you have submitted your application, Deakin University will let you know whether your application has been successful. If it is, you will be sent your Letter of Offer via email.

3. PAY YOUR FEES

When an offer is made, you will need to pay all DUELI fees (enrolment fee and tuition fee) in full. You will be given a choice to:

- Pay your fees through Deakin's payment portal, or
- Use one of our online international payment providers (other payment options).

Deakin payment portal

If you select this option, you will have a choice to pay via credit card, FlyWire or PayPal. It will automatically list your full deposit amount – you will not be able to pay in multiple instalments through the portal.

Other payment options

You can also pay your deposit in part or in full through FlyWire, Western Union Global Pay, or financial guarantee (for sponsored students).

Depending on the method you use to pay your fees, you may need to upload proof of payment in the Studylink Application Portal, so that our admissions staff can review and progress your acceptance. Learn more at deakin.edu.au/fees.

4. RECEIVE A CONFIRMATION OF ENROLMENT (COE) AND APPLY FOR A VISA

Once we receive your fees, a CoE document will be sent to you. If you are studying in Australia, you will need this document to obtain a student visa from the Australian Diplomatic Mission in your country. You will be sent a Notification of Arrival form which must be sent back to Deakin University at least 10 days prior to arrival in Australia with details of your arrival date and flight.

If you are taking part in online study from your home country, you will not need to apply for a visa.
