Students will need to meet the eligibility requirements and provide the necessary supporting documentation in order to be considered for the scholarship.

Supporting documents

Applicants are required to provide:

- a completed Vietnam Partners Scholarship application form (see reverse side of this flyer),
- a completed application to study at Deakin University, including academic transcripts.

Eligibility and selection criteria

Applicants must:

- be a prospective international student;
- be a citizen of Vietnam
- · be eligible to study at Deakin
- have not accepted any other Deakin scholarship or bursary;
- meet the academic entry requirements for the course, including English language requirements
- be starting an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework
 Deakin degree (except for courses offered by Faculty of Science
 Engineering and Built Environment)
- · meet the academic criteria for the scholarship.

Academic criteria

For undergraduate degrees applicants must meet one of the following in most recent qualification/studies:

- have studied the equivalent of one trimester at any university and achieved a WAM of at least 65%, OR
- have completed studies at any high school and achieved a WAM of at least 82% in Grade 12.

For postgraduate degrees* applicants must:

- have studied the equivalent of one trimester at any university and achieved a WAM of at least 65%, OR
- have completed a bachelor degree at any university and achieved a WAM of at least 65%.
