TERMS OF USE: HDR EXAMINATIONS

- 1. These terms of use apply to each Deakin University Research Degree students who submits a thesis for examination through the online examination system, HDR Examinations.
- 2. You should familiarise yourself with the <u>Higher Degrees by Research assessment procedure</u> and the Examination Procedures. By submitting your thesis for examination, you acknowledge that you have done so.
- 3. You must upload your thesis in portable document format (pdf) to HDR Examinations, together with any supporting material referred to in the Examinations Procedures. If you require assistance uploading your thesis, please email <u>research-examinations@deakin.edu.au</u>.
- 4. Deakin is unable to, and does not, guarantee that the system will be available 24 hours, 7 days per week or that it will be error free. If you experience any difficulties uploading your thesis or otherwise, please email <u>research-examinations@deakin.edu.au</u>.
- 5. You will know when your thesis has been successfully uploaded because a message to that effect will be displayed. If you are concerned that your thesis may not have been successfully uploaded, please immediately email <u>research-examinations@deakin.edu.au</u>.
- 6. When you upload your thesis, your examiners will be notified by email and will be able to access and download your thesis via HDR Examinations. You acknowledge that the document you upload to the system will be the document that is examined. You are responsible for ensuring that the document you upload is the document you wish to be examined.
- 7. You further acknowledge that your examiners may request that a hard copy of your thesis be produced for examination. In that case, if you have requested Deakin to produce a hard copy of your thesis, by clicking the acceptance box, Deakin will (at its cost) print and bind your thesis and arrange for it to be delivered to your examiners for examination. You authorise Deakin to do all things reasonably necessary to print, bind and arrange delivery of your thesis.
- 8. The hard copy of your thesis produced by Deakin (if applicable) will be printed directly from the document you upload to the system. Deakin accepts no responsibility in respect of any errors or defects in the hard copy of the thesis produced by Deakin (whether in relation to printing, binding or otherwise) or in relation to any issues arising in connection with the delivery of the thesis to your examiners including any delay in delivery.
- 9. If you decide not to request Deakin to produce a hard copy of your thesis, you will be responsible (at your cost) for arranging for your thesis to be printed and bound and delivered to the Examinations Officer, who will in turn arrange for it to be delivered to your examiners for examination.
