They'll be prepared for employment in a variety of professional roles from media advisor to policy officer. Developed by the #1 sport science school in the world<sup>\*</sup>, students will develop the skills to become a professional leader in exercise and sport science and allied fields, with a focus on the biological, sociological and behavioural bases of exercise and sport science.

A diverse range of majors ensures that students can tailor their degree to their career goals, before diving deeper into their area of interest by completing an original research project as part of the embedded honours year.

Leveraging Deakin's strong industry partnerships, students will complete 220 hours of placement experience within a variety of environments such as: professional sporting clubs, governing bodies, high performance centres, recreational gyms, and rehabilitation clinics ensuring they graduate job-ready.

### Laboratory Science Work Experience

A one-week work experience program will be offered to highachieving Year 10 students who are passionate about science, preferably in molecular biology/ cell science.

Students will experience laboratory science in a hands-on and demonstrative environment. The program will include participation in micro-molecular biological techniques, invertebrate and vertebrate biology, chemistry practicals, tracking and mapping using GPS/GIS, ecological survey techniques and more. ### Bachelor of Occupational Therapy coming to Warrnambool in 2024

We are very excited to announce that the Bachelor of Occupational Therapy will be offered at our Warrnambool campus from Trimester 1, 2024, in addition to the Geelong Waterfront campus.

If your students are passionate about promoting good health and wellbeing and improving people's quality of life, Deakin's Bachelor of Occupational Therapy will equip them with the knowledge and skills to identify people's strengths and limitations, environmental and social supports and barriers, and the role these play in people's ability to participate in occupations meaningful to them.

With job opportunities in the sector expected to grow by 23.3% by 2026, your students will graduate career ready with the expertise to develop personalised, evidence-based intervention plans with people whose health and wellbeing is affected by issues including injury, illness, disability or environmental barriers. 1000 hours of practice education placement gives them invaluable hands-on experience.

If your school is in a regional or rural area your students will also be able apply for this course through our **Regional and Remote Entry Scheme** so they can improve people's quality of life in their own communities.

Please note as the Warrnambool offering and Regional and Remote Entry Scheme for this course have recently been approved these are yet to be reflected on Deakin's website.


This new facility advances Victoria's film production capabilities, provides fantastic learning opportunities and enhances Victoria's creative industries.

Virtual production is the culmination of film and gaming technology. Students now have a unique opportunity to collaborate on a variety of different film making disciplines both traditional and new. Employment in the arts and media sector is growing with job opportunities projected to increase by 8.7% over a five-year period to 2026. (2021 Employment Projections to 2026, Jobs and Skills Australia.)

With this new Deakin Dreamscreen partnership there's an opportunity for 25 industry placements with Dreamscreen. Students will graduate with real-world expertise and practical skills.
