On Wednesday 25 July, Deakin Student Recruitment in collaboration with our Faculty of Arts & Education were pleased to host a one of a kind webinar session with Altus Assessments, the delivering partner of the CASPer online Education screening tool.

Streaming live from Canada, Altus engaged with Careers Practitioners at each of our Deakin campuses. The session focused on Altus' top 10 tips for those undertaking the CASPer test, as well as information about how test scores are assessed, and what the theory is behind the test.

Faculty of Health

New combined course – Bachelor of Exercise and Sport Science/Bachelor of Nutrition Science

Deakin University is currently developing an exciting new combined course offering for 2019! The Bachelor of Exercise and Sport Science/Bachelor of Nutrition Science* will be offered by Deakin's School of Exercise and Nutrition Sciences, which has been ranked the #1 sport science school in the world for two consecutive years^.

This new course is the first of its kind in Victoria and will prepare students to combine exercise and nutrition to help the community optimise physical performance and nutrition, and contribute to the prevention of diet and physical activity related diseases.

Like our graduates of the Bachelor of Exercise and Sport Science, graduates of this new combined course will be eligible for accreditation with Exercise and Sport Science Australia (ESSA) to become accredited exercise scientists.

Faculty of Arts and Education

Bachelor of Arts (and associated courses)

Deakin's Bachelor of Arts (and associated courses) major of Studies in religions will be renamed to Religious studies from Trimester 1, 2019.

Faculty of Business and Law

Bachelor of Business Analytics

Deakin's **Bachelor of Information Systems** has been changed to **Bachelor of Business Analytics**. This course will teach students how to use technology to capture and use digital information effectively in organisational settings. Students will focus on critically analysing an organisation's information in order to decide on the best business analytics software (e.g. business intelligence, predictive analytics and social media analytics tools) to solve real-life business problems.

Our new Bachelor of Business Analytics is also the only specialist business analytics program in Victoria and one of only two in Australia.

Regional and Remote Entry Scheme

Don't forget, Deakin's Regional and Remote Entry Scheme is available to applicants who completed their Year 12 studies in a school located in any non-metro area of Australia or from within the City of Greater Geelong. Eligible applicants may receive up to a 10 aggregate point adjustment towards their entry score for admission for the following courses:

This course will articulate into the second year of the Bachelor of Design (3D Animation, Bachelor of Design (Digital Technologies) and Bachelor of Design (Visual Communication) at Deakin University.

Diploma of Communication

The Diploma of Media and Communication will change to the Diploma of Communication from Trimester 1, 2019. This course articulates into the second year of the Bachelor of Communication (advertising), Bachelor of Communication (Digital Media), Bachelor of Communication (Journalism) and the Bachelor of Communication (Public Relations) at Deakin University.

Diploma of Business

The Diploma of Management will change to the Diploma of Business from Trimester 1, 2019. This course articulates into the second year of the Bachelor of Business at Deakin University.

**CAMPUS CHANGES****Faculty of Arts and Education****Associate Degree of Arts (A250)**

There will be no Cloud campus intake for 2019

Bachelor of Early Childhood Education (E330)

This course will no longer be offered at the Waurn Ponds Campus, Warrnambool Campus or any Learning Centres from 2019. These students will instead enroll in the Cloud Campus and attend intensive classes.

Bachelor of International Studies

The Geelong offering will move from the Waurn Ponds Campus to the Waterfront Campus from Trimester 1, 2019.

Faculty of Science, Engineering and Built Environment**Bachelor of Science – Warrnambool Campus**

**DISCONTINUED COURSES****Faculty of Arts and Education****Bachelor of Arts – Chinese/Bachelor of Commerce (D317)**

This course will be discontinued from 2019.

Faculty of Health**Bachelor of Psychology (Professional Streams)**

This course has been discontinued however, Deakin continues to offer exciting majors through our other undergraduate psychology courses. Students can explore evolving options in both the Bachelor of Psychological Science and the Bachelor of Psychology (Honours).

Faculty of Science, Engineering and Built Environment**Bachelor of Biological Science**

The Bachelor of Biological Science, offered in the Burwood campus, will be discontinued from Trimester 1, 2019. The course has significant overlap in the content and learning outcomes to the Bachelor of Science course. Students interested in this discipline area are encouraged to explore the study areas within the Bachelor of Science as an alternative.
