Welcome back to Term 3!

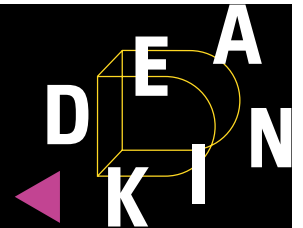

In this program, students will complete two units of a first-year university subject at the same time as their Year 12 studies.

They'll study one unit per trimester, alongside first-year university students, completing their units either on campus, or at the Cloud Campus – our innovative online learning environment.

Deakin Accelerate gives your students the same benefits as studying a fifth or sixth VCE subject, while gaining university credit and reducing the cost of their future degree.

Updated Course information

Bachelor of Exercise and Sport Science/ Bachelor of Nutrition Science in Geelong

We are very excited to let you know our Bachelor of Exercise and Sport Science/Bachelor of Nutrition Science will be offered at the Geelong Waurn Ponds Campus from Trimester 1 2021, in addition to the Melbourne Burwood Campus.

This combined degree gives students the opportunity to study two complementary fields and understand how the whole athlete works, as well as the fuel required to enable them to perform at their best. Students have the opportunity to participate in a minimum of 220 hours of invaluable practical experience and benefit from career mentoring, setting them apart from other graduates.

Offered by the #1 ranked sport science school in Australia, exercise and sports science at Deakin gives our students a nationally recognised, field-leading education in improving the performance, health and participation of individuals and teams. Complementing this, the nutrition science component of this combined course provides an understanding of the nature of food and the importance of nutrition for individual and population health.

Deakin is excited to launch two new early childhood and primary education courses for 2021.

From Trimester 1 2021, our existing Bachelor of Education (Early Years) will be replaced with the following new courses:

- **Bachelor of Early Childhood Education – 3 years duration**
- **Bachelor of Early Childhood and Primary Education – 4 years duration**

Early childhood is a booming industry and we're pleased to be able to offer a new suite of courses to meet the growing industry demands. The introduction of a new three-year early childhood degree will provide students with an opportunity to enter the workforce 12 months sooner.

The new four-year combined degree allows for maximum flexibility for students to pursue a career in either early childhood or primary education settings.

The two degrees have been structured in a way that allows early childhood students to seamlessly transition into the combined degree, to complete the primary education component, should they wish to do so.
