



Complying with requirements for admission to legal practice

If you wish to be admitted to Australian legal practice, but studied Law in another jurisdiction, you will need to apply to the Victorian Legal Admissions Board (VLAB) or another state’s Admitting Authority for an assessment of your qualifications. If you are required to study certain academic areas of knowledge in order to qualify for admission to practice, you will be provided with a letter specifying those areas of knowledge.

Choosing your units

- The table below indicates the units of study at Deakin that teach the academic areas of knowledge.
- If you have been required to undertake two or more academic areas of knowledge, the [Graduate Certificate of Australian Law](#) might be right for you. You will be required to take [MLP709 Constitutional Law and Policy](#) as well as three electives from the list of postgraduate core law units.
- If your letter requires you to study only 2 or 3 units, Recognition of Prior Learning may be available, so that you do not need to study electives in the [Graduate Certificate of Australian Law](#) that are not specified in your letter. - If you are enrolling in one or more single (non-award) law units then you may choose to enrol in either postgraduate or undergraduate law units. Postgraduate law units tend to be distinguished from the undergraduate units by their greater focus on policy issues.
