2021 Deakin Accelerate programs

Applications are now open for the 2021 Deakin Accelerate program.

Deakin Accelerate is a distinctive VCE extension studies program designed to challenge high-achieving students with university-level learning opportunities. Students get the same benefits as studying a fifth or sixth VCE subject, while gaining university credit and reducing the cost of their future degree.

In this program, students will complete two units of a first-year university subject at the same time as their Year 12 studies. They'll study one unit per trimester, alongside first-year university students, completing their units either on campus, or on the Cloud Campus – our innovative online learning environment.

Deakin Scholarships

Deakin has a range of scholarships aimed at acknowledging and rewarding students – be it academic prowess, contribution to community, leadership, extracurricular achievements, course of study, or perseverance despite hardship.

Our scholarship program includes three major awards:

- **Vice-Chancellor's Academic Excellence Scholarship:** 100% tuition fees covered; plus \$5000 cash payment per year and a place in the Vice-Chancellor's Professional Excellence Program.
- **Deakin Scholarship for Excellence:** \$5000 per year, with the option to be paid as cash or to tuition fees, or a combination of both.
- **Deakin Student Support Scholarship:** financial support ranging from \$1000 one-off payment up to \$10 000 per year for students experiencing financial or personal hardship.

CASPer Test Dates

Students applying to study teaching at Deakin University must successfully complete the CASPer test, which is an online situational judgement test measuring non-academic suitability for teaching.
