

Discover DEAKIN Course information webinars


Are your students interested in a particular study area?

Professional Resilience: Building Skills to Thrive

Deakin University offers a free massive open online course (MOOC) that equips learners with the ability to better manage stress through the development of practical resilience skills, strategies and exercises.

During this course students will be invited to craft a personal approach to resiliency based on a wide survey of evidence-based strategies. Students will discover the importance of resiliency for building mental health and wellbeing in a rapidly changing world.

The Professional Resiliency Course invites secondary students to consider what they might be able to do right now that could help support them and their communities into the future. This is a rare opportunity for senior secondary students to study resilience early in their working lives.
