A **reset room** is available in the campus library (**Building B**) as a quiet, low-sensory space to rest and recharge.



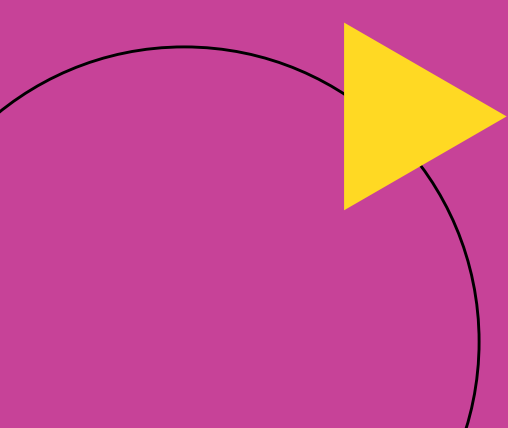
HIDDEN DISABILITIES SUNFLOWER PROGRAM
