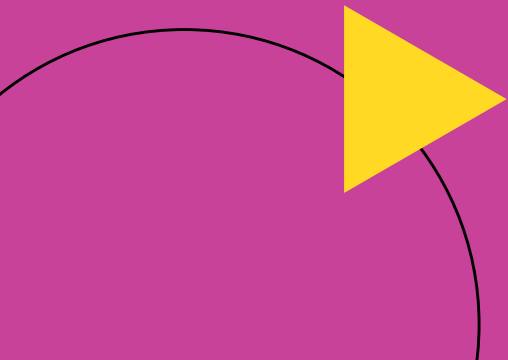
HIDDEN DISABILITIES SUNFLOWER PROGRAM

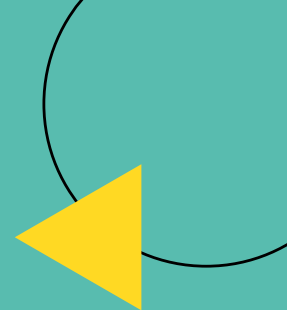

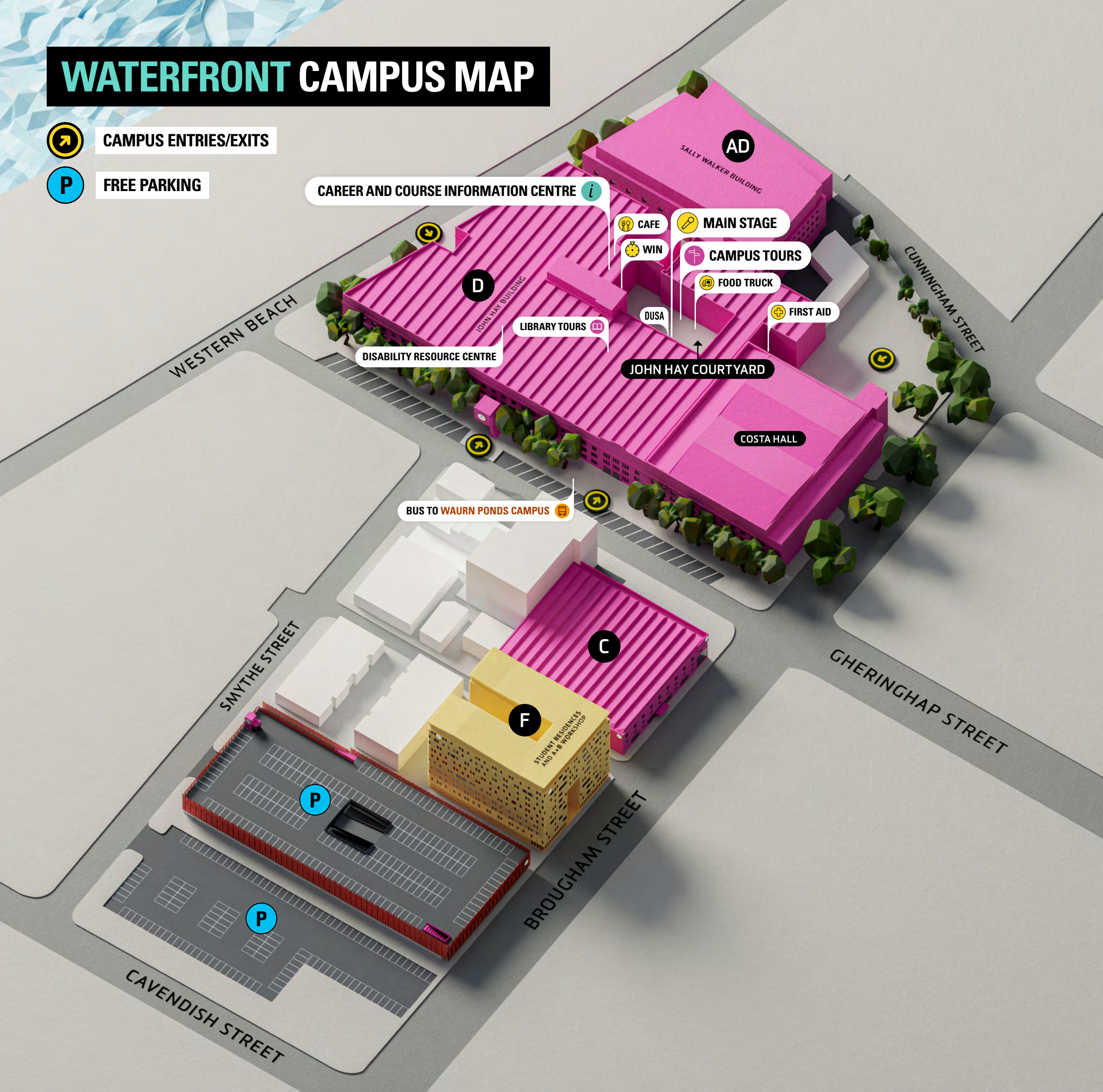
