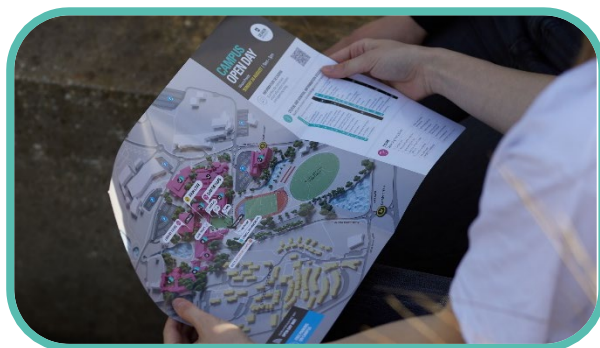
Deakin University Geelong Waterfront Campus is located at **1 Gheringhap Street, Geelong, Victoria 3220**.

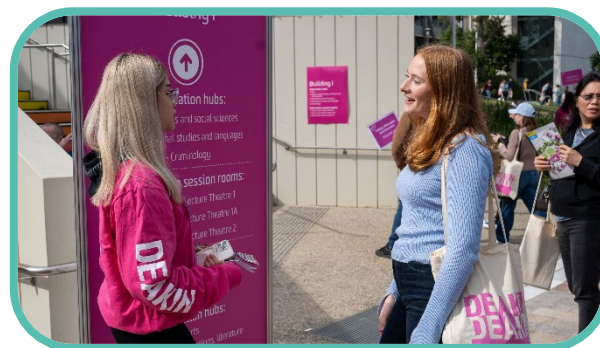

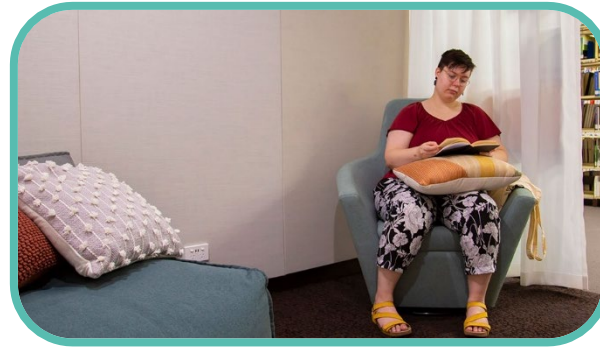
