NOTE: To progress into the Master of Architecture level of studies from undergraduate architecture, students must have completed all 24 credit points of the undergraduate course and also achieve a Weighted Average Mark (WAM) of 65. Students achieving a WAM between 55 and 64 have the opportunity to submit a portfolio of relevant work and personal statement for consideration to potentially progress into the master level of studies. A WAM of less than 55 results in an alternative exit from D306 Bachelor of Design (Architecture)/Master of Architecture with the award: S342 Bachelor of Design (Architecture).

NOTE: Students may select elective units from any level 7 SR coded unit except for SRR720 Construction Research Frontiers and SRR721 Construction Research Project [An alternative elective may be undertaken and will require approval by the S700 Master of Architecture Course Director.]

NOTE: Students intending to apply for entry into Higher Degree by Research may be required to complete SRD756 Architectural Design Thesis Part 1 (2cp) and SRR711 Thesis (2cp)

NOTE: Some of the elective options are 0.5 credit point micro-credentials. 2 micro-credentials need to be completed to achieve 1 credit point of study.

NOTE: SRD756 Architectural Design Thesis Part 1 and SRD766 Architectural Design Thesis Part 2 to be completed in consecutive trimesters.
