Nursing or Midwifery English Language requirements

To be considered for the nursing or midwifery courses listed in your application, it is an Australian Nursing and Midwifery Accreditation Council (ANMAC) accreditation requirement that to be eligible to enrol into the course, you have met the English Language requirements of the ANMAC Accreditation Standards leading to initial registration with Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA). These requirements include a written declaration that English is your primary language or evidence of achievement of the minimum English language test result as specified as specified in the NMBA English language skills registration standard.

This form will only need to be completed once, even if you change your course preferences.

How can I meet the requirements?

English as your primary language: you must have attended and satisfactorily completed at least six years of primary and secondary education taught and assessed solely in English. At least two years of this education must have been between grades 7 and 12. This education must have been completed in one or more of the recognised countries: Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, United Kingdom, or United States of America.

Or

English Language Test: if you do not meet the requirements for the above pathway, you will need to complete an approved English Language Test as part of your application: IELTS (academic module), PTE Academic or OET and achieve the minimum scores.

IELTS (Academic): minimum overall score of 7.0, (includes minimum score of 7.0 in Speaking, Reading, and Listening, and minimum score of 6.5 in Writing)

OET: minimum score of 350 in Listening and Writing and 360 in Reading and Speaking

PTE Academic: minimum score of 63 (includes minimum score of 58 in Listening, 59 in Reading, 60 in Writing and 76 in Speaking)
