Deakin is proud to bring the 2017 Access Education VCE Revision Lecture program to our Warrnambool and Geelong Waterfront campuses.

The VCE Revision Lecture program allows students studying a VCE Unit 3/4 to revise the unit content in a supported and structured environment helping students prepare for their end of year exam. The lectures are facilitated by VCE professionals, who are subject experts in their field.

Each lecture runs for approximately 2 ½ hours and covers:

- general and subject-specific exam strategies
- tips to better understand and tackle exam questions
- subject-specific study notes prepared by the academics
- pointers on previous year's exam pitfalls.

Deakin Scholarships rewarding excellence

Deakin has a range of scholarships aimed to acknowledge and reward students – be it academic prowess, contribution to community, leadership, extracurricular achievements, course of study or perseverance despite hardship.

With a diverse range of offerings, Deakin's scholarship program includes three major awards:

- Vice-Chancellor's Academic Excellence Scholarship: 100% tuition fees waived; \$5000 cash payment per year; a place in the Vice-Chancellor's Professional Excellence Program
- Deakin Scholarship for Excellence: \$5000 paid as cash or towards tuition fees per year, or a combination of both to the value of \$5000 per year
- Deakin Student Support Scholarship: financial support of up to \$10 000 per year.

Deakin also offers a range of generous donor scholarships that support excellence, achievement, hardship, students enrolled in a particular course, or from a specific region or background.

A Deakin scholarship is more than simply a financial boost. It's a remarkable opportunity to stand out from the crowd, be recognised by leading employers, and make a unique mark on the world.

► Exclusive scholarships available for commencing students

If you have students interested in travelling as part of their degree, then consider the Global Science and Technology Program. This scholarship program is open to all courses offered by the Faculty of Science, Engineering and Built Environment and aims to recognise, reward and support high achieving students interested in conducting part of their studies overseas in order to develop new skills and a broader world view. Successful applicants will receive a \$3000 scholarship to assist with travel costs and will participate in the Deakin Global Citizenship Program. ► IGNITED Scholarship

The **IGNITED Scholarship** has been created to ignite female interest in areas of study and work that are traditionally under-represented by women, including engineering, information technology and construction management. This scholarship is open to female students entering an approved undergraduate degree. Each scholarship is valued at \$5000 per year for the normal duration of the course and recipients are also assigned an academic mentor. ► AusNet Services Scholarship

Three **AusNet Services Women in Power Engineering scholarships** are on offer to support women to achieve tertiary qualifications in power engineering, preparing them for diverse and rewarding careers in the energy industry. Scholarships are awarded to successful female applicants entering Deakin's Bachelor of Electrical and Electronics Engineering (Honours) undergraduate degree. Each scholarship is valued at \$10 000 per year over the normal duration of your course and includes vocational work and a mentoring program.
